2026-2027 Preschool Classes

Thank you for your interest in Redeemer! This information sheet provides descriptions of our preschool classes offered for the 2026-2027 school year. Please read all details carefully.

Registration for the 3's, 4's, and full-day tuition-based preschool classes is handled entirely online. Enrollment for new families will open in mid-February 2026 and will remain open until classes are full.

Application for the PreK Counts class is handled online as well; this class has a different enrollment process. See the PreK Counts class description for more details.

Children must be independent in the bathroom for all Redeemer preschool classes.

3's AM Class: Our 3's preschool class meets Tuesday and Thursday mornings at our Oakmont campus. Children must be 3 years old by November 1st. Class size will be capped at 16 students with two teachers. Application and enrollment for this class is handled entirely online.

4's AM Class: Our 4's preschool class meets Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings at our Oakmont campus. Children must be at least 4 years old by November 1st. Class size will be capped at 18 students with two teachers. Application and enrollment for this class is handled entirely online.

5-day AM PreK Class: Our 5-day AM prek class meets Monday-Friday mornings at our Oakmont campus. Children must be at least kindergarten eligible for 2027-2028 and have previously attended at least one year of preschool to enroll in this class. Application and enrollment for this class is handled entirely online.

Full-day Class: Our full-day tuition-based preschool class meets Monday-Friday at our Oakmont campus. Children must be at least 3 years old by September 1st. Application and enrollment for this class is handled entirely online.

Flex Full-day option: Parents may also enroll children in the full-day tuition-based preschool class to attend 2 or 3 days per week. Children must be at least 3 years old by September 1st. The attendance days for these options must remain consistent from week to week; children who enroll in these options will need to attend the same 2 or 3 days every week. Application and enrollment for these options is handled entirely online.

Redeemer Lutheran School PreK Counts Program

The remaining class option is a daily preschool class; it is operated under the "PreK Counts" program. This class is offered at no cost to families who qualify. Tuition is covered by a state grant; families must submit applications with complete financial information for 2025 in order to be considered.

Daily attendance is required. Children must be 3 or 4 years of age by September 1st and independent in the restroom in order to apply.

Our full-day Penn Hills campus preschool class meets Monday-Friday. Morning snack and lunch are provided every day as part of the program. There are two teachers to oversee this class.

If you are interested in the PreK Counts class, view the income requirements listed below to determine if you qualify. Your adjusted gross income cannot exceed the amount listed for your family size. Application is handled online for this preschool program; please contact Alison Jackson at 412-793-5884 or admissions@redeemer-oakmont.org for the link to the application. Parents must provide copies of the following items in order for the application to be considered:

- Child's birth certificate
- Child's immunizations record from the doctor's office
- Record of all household income for 2025: tax return is preferred, or family provides copies of all W-2 or paystubs, SNAP, TANF, child support, unemployment, etc.
- Proof of residency (utility bill, mortgage bill, rental lease/agreement)

The number of applications received for the PreK Counts classes is typically greater than the number of available spaces. Applications will be reviewed using selection criteria provided by the state, and families will be contacted with the results of the review by May 1st.
